- Above ground tanks
- Away from the river
- Close to fixed base operators
- Doesn't take tie-down or hangar space
- Includes environmental protections
- Located in an industrial zone
- No tree loss
- Sea level rise and saltwater inundation mitigation
- Sustainable fuel storage

### **Alternatives**





- 2800 feet from the river
- Away from homes
- In an industrial zone
- Does not displace hangars or tiedowns

#### Cons

 Removes opportunity for new hangar or tiedown space

- Would not displace hangars or tiedowns

#### Cons

- Away from most airport support services
- 950 feet from the river




- Away from homes
