Side Sewer Replacement Project is now complete.

King County and Skyway Water and Sewer District have **completed** the project to replace side sewers serving 332 residential properties; repair or replace public sewer mains and manholes; and disconnect improper storm drainage connections to the sanitary sewer. This project was designed to remove excess stormwater and groundwater flows into the local sewer system, eliminating the need for a large regional wastewater storage facility in the area.



What to expect

- Restoration of the entire project area is complete. Construction crews and equipment are out of the neighborhood.
- The 24 Hour Construction Hotline is no longer active; please use the contact information below if you have questions regarding project completion or restoration on your property.
- King County will send a post-construction survey to all project area residents in order to continually improve community outreach and project performance. Watch for the survey in the mail this summer.
- If your side sewer was replaced, you will receive a new sewer card in the mail later this summer showing the details of the recent replacement.
- Road repaving and overlay throughout the project area is expected to occur in the summer of 2013.
