



Combined Sewer Overflow Control Program Budget Proviso

Presented to Rates and Finance and Engineering and Planning Subcommittees of the Metropolitan Water Pollution Abatement Advisory Committee May 2, 2013

Background Information

- Proviso included as part of 2013 King County Budget Ordinance
- Purpose is to evaluate alternative sequencing option(s) of the CSO control projects approved in September 2012
 - To analyze effects of initiating more CSO control projects while borrowing costs and interest rates are at historic lows
 - To evaluate effects of accelerating projects in relation to coordination with other projects, regulatory approvals, staffing requirements, and environmental benefits
- Proviso report is due to King County Council by Sept. 1, 2013



Scope of Work

Scope of work includes:

- Comparing benefits and impacts of Council-approved sequencing with an alternative option that accelerates the HLKK CSO Treatment Plant project
- Analysis includes looking at rate impacts and any associated regulatory, staffing, coordination, or human and environmental health benefits or impacts
- The water quality assessment and monitoring study will provide a more in-depth look at options for integrating and sequencing CSO control projects. Findings from the study will inform the next CSO control program review in 2017.
