February 6, 2022 Meeting
for February 2022 MWPAAAC General Meeting**

Capital Projects Update

WTD provided an update on 3 of the 200 ongoing capital projects:

- Georgetown Wet Weather Treatment Station - a combined sewer overflow project that collects flows from the Brandon Street/Michigan Street areas (south of the stadiums). It will treat up to 70 million gallons per day (mgd), removing 70% of the solids before discharge to the Duwamish River. Construction of this \$275 million project is about 90 percent complete, on schedule, and within budget.
- North Mercer/Enatai Interceptor Upgrade - provides additional pipe and pump station capacity – also presented to E&P in December 2021 (see December 2, 2021 summary meeting notes from E&P)
- Coal Creek Interceptor Upgrade - provides additional pipe capacity and moves interceptor out of sensitive creek area – also presented to E&P in January 2022 (see January 6, 2022 summary meeting notes from E&P)
