
Biosolids Program Lifetime Distribution and Diversity



Program Implications Landfill Diversion

- Forestry application began
- Land reclamation application at high
- Compost partnership formed
- >40% of product landfilled

Program Implications Maximum Diversity

- Agricultural application in Eastern Washington began
- Forestry application expanded
- Compost partner production expanded Land reclamation application ended
- 100% beneficial use

Program Implications Agricultural Expansion

- Agricultural application in Eastern Washington expanded
- Forestry application decreased

Program Implications Options Narrowed

- >90% agricultural application in Eastern Washington
- Forestry application sharply decreased Forestry application at historic highs

Program Implications Recovering, But Vulnerable

- 65% agricultural application in Eastern Washington
- Land reclamation application continued Compost partner production decreased <1% product used by compost partner Compost partner closed business in 2020, ending compost production
 - Application sites currently robust, but narrow and vulnerable to climate change impacts
