



Upcoming Trail Construction:

Week of 6 September

- STA 292+50 - 297+75: Begin rock wall removal
- STA 283+00 – 350+75: Disconnect trailside electrical fixtures.
- STA 283+00 – 350+75: Continue potholing to locate buried utilities.
- STA 329+24 - 375+50: Install high visibility silt fence, following tree removal.
- STA 329+24 - 375+50: Install high visibility fence, following tree removal.
- STA 352+36 - 375+50: Continue tree pruning and removal.
- STA 352+36 - 375+50. Continue clearing and grubbing.
- STA 352+36 - 375+50: Mitigation area clearing
- STA 352+36 - 375+50: Continue site security fence installation.
- STA 352+36 - 375+50: Survey trail centerline

- STA 289+20 - 291+50: Excavate and grade for Wall 1
- STA 290+00 - 291+50: Begin drainage system construction at Waverly Beach
- STA 290+00 - 291+50: Install storm drains
