	Calendaring and Transportation of Jailed Defendants to Court

Numerous defendants are picked up and held in the King County Jail pending the scheduling of hearings in each of the District Courts. A courtroom is available in the King County Jail. The cost of transportation of prisoners to the District Courts has a significant impact upon the King County Annual Budget. In order to reduce or eliminate the necessity of transporting defendants to the District Courts, and in order to assure the expeditious and efficient handling of these cases;

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. All defendants held in the King County Jail by virtue of an order, warrant or complaint from an outlying District Court shall be placed on the appropriate Seattle District Court jail calendar for a courtesy bail hearing. If the defendant is held on a State or County case, is in the Pre-Trial stage and the defendant is not released, venue shall be transferred to the Seattle District Court for all further proceedings.
- 2. All State and County defendants held in the King County Jail by virtue of an order or warrant from any District Court other than Seattle, who are in the Post-Trial or Post-Guilty Plea stage, shall be placed on a Revocation and Review Calendar that shall be heard by the Presiding Judge pursuant to the procedures set forth on the attached memorandum.
