WHICH CHANGED VENUE FOR CIVIL CASES FILED
BY AGENCIES LISTED IN 2-28-1990 ORDER, WHEREIN
VENUE WAS CHANGED FROM AUKEEN DISTRICT
(NOW AUKEEN DIVISION) TO SOUTHWEST DISTRICT
(NOW SOUTHWEST DIVISION)

The Executive Committee of the King County District Court on October 18, 1991, voted to authorize the Presiding Judge, the undersigned, to enter an order rescinding the Order of February 28, 1990. The District Court is entering a new alignment regarding criminal fillings due to changes and anticipated changes in municipal courts organization and police assignments. In positioning the District Court to react to these changes, a baseline of fillings related to traditional electoral district geography and the general venue rules for the King County District Court will be established. Pursuant to ARLJ 5:

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That the Order of the King County District Courts Presiding Judge entered the 28th day of February, 1990, is hereby rescinded as of the close of normal business hours for the King County District Court on the 31st day of December, 1991.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the Administrators of the Southwest Division and the Aukeen Division of the King County District Court shall each notify all agencies who have been previously notified to file pursuant to the February 28, 1990 Order, that they should as of the first court day of 1992 commence filing in the Divisions where venue is established in the general venue rule for the King County District Court.
