	Standing Order Authorizing Transfer and Acceptance of Supervision	

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the King County Probation Department is:

- 1. Authorized to transfer appropriate cases to other participating probation departments for presentence investigation, probation supervision and deferred prosecution monitoring;
- 2. Authorized to accept cases from other probation departments for courtesy supervision at the director's discretion;
- 3. Authorized to collect and retain supervision fees on accepted cases and permit other departments to collect and retain fees on this Court's cases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this authorization shall apply to any probation cases currently under courtesy supervision.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT THE KING COUNTY DISTRICT COURT will accept written report, in lieu of personal appearance and testimony, from probation staff in other jurisdictions to substantiate an offender's progress and/or any violations of probation/deferred prosecution.
