**GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
GAO 19-04**

This GAO modifies GAO 16-07

Judge Supervised Probation Violation Report
Standards from 7 days to 10 days.

Pursuant to GAO 16-07, Probation Officer and Clerks performing probation supervision or compliance monitoring are required to report to the sentencing/supervising judge a violation within seven (7) business days of discovery of the violation(s) set forth in sections:

- I. E For new violations of law or outstanding bench warrants;
- II. A. For violations of conditions(s) of Probation; and
- III. C. For violations of any monitoring standard set forth in GAO 16-07 or other Court order on the case.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: The above provision in GAO 16-07 for reporting said violation(s) to the sentencing/supervision judge is amended to require reporting the violation(s) within ten (10) business days of discovery of the violation, rather than seven (7) business days as previously ordered. No other provision of GAO 16-07 are changed and remain in effect until further order of the court.
