GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
Re: Infraction disposition for cases
filed prior to 2005

The King County District Court is in the process of closing old infraction cases in preparation for the implementation of a new database system. In reviewing these old files, the court has discovered many cases which have no judgment or disposition entered and no Failure to Appear/Respond (FTA) issued. In many of these cases a monetary penalty was assessed and there may be a collection history. If ten years has elapsed since the date of violation, the Court finds these cases are no longer adjudicable and the financial obligations are no longer collectible, and further proceedings in the cases would not be in the interest of justice.

Therefore, it is now ORDERED:

In cases of civil infractions that are more than ten years old from the date of violation, and in which the court record does not show a finding or judgment of "committed", the clerk shall enter an order of dismissal, shall write off all legal financial obligations and cease any collection activity unless there is an active garnishment, and shall close the case.
