
The King County District Court is in the process of reviewing and closing old criminal cases as part of data clean-up project in preparation for adoption of a new case management system. In reviewing these cases, the court has discovered numerous cases over 10 years old where there is no final disposition on Deferred Prosecution, S.O.C. or a Deferred Sentence. An administrative order is needed to expedite and to provide order and consistency to the final closure of these cases.

Where there has been no finding, garnishment proceedings or order extending the judgment entered on these cases the court deems that if the defendant has fully complied with the conditions, with the exception of the financial obligation(s), these cases shall be dismissed and the financial obligations be written off.

Accordingly, it is Ordered:

The clerk shall verify that all conditions of the Deferred Prosecution, S.O.C. or Deferred Sentence have been complied with except for an outstanding financial obligation. The clerk shall dismiss the Deferred Prosecution, S.O.C. or Deferred Sentence and write off all outstanding costs, fees and assessments.
