GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 20-08

Re: Pre-Conviction Restitution, Driving While
Under the Influence Emergency Response-
Aid, Fire and Response Funds


District Court will not accept any form of payment or track any payments for funds related to: agreements to pay restitution to victims pursuant to a diversion agreement or stipulated order of continuance (SOC); Driving While Under the Influence Emergency Response-Aid (DEA) recoupment for local ambulance or emergency aid response costs; Driving While Under the Influence Emergency Response-Fire (DEF) recoupment for local fire protection response costs and Driving While Under the Influence Emergency Response (DER) recoupment for local emergency response costs.

District Court will accept and track payments and process payments to victims for Orders of Restitution entered post- conviction only. Funds for DEA, DEF, DER shall be remitted by the individual ordered to pay these costs directly to the recovering agency.

Therefore, it is now ORDERED:

All funds related to pre-conviction restitution, DEA, DEF, and DER are no longer accepted by District Court.
