Balcom

1. In which zones can a community food bank operate?

Although each specific situation must be evaluated individually, a food bank may be permitted in the following classifications (subject to any conditions listed for that use):

a) Reuse of closed public school facilities, retained in the ownership of the school district, for non-profit agencies providing community services and goods delivery: RS, RD-3600, RM-2400, RM-1800, RM-900, SE, SC, SR.

b) Reuse of nonresidential structures or other developed facilities which were built in the zone for permitted uses, with an administrative conditional use permit: RS, RD-3600, RM-2400, RM-1800, RM-900, SE, SC, SR.

- c) Uses rendering governmental, social or personal services to the individual: RM-900 (K.C.C. 21.16.020(P)).
- d) Uses rendering professional services or personal services to the individual: BN, BR-N, BC, BR-C, CG.
